Today, the catalogue boasts 6,000 titles with 500 new titles added yearly. In 2020, Albin Michel diversified its activities by launching a comics division with major hits such as: *Sapiens*, a graphic adaptation of the best-selling essay by Yuval Noah Harari, with rights already sold in 36 languages, and the historical graphic novel *Deux Filles Nues* by Luz, which has sold 100,000 copies in France so far and is sold in 8 languages.
